In consideration for being allowed to practice, compete in, officiate, work for, observe, or participate in any way in the activities of AGC or any event hosted by or on the property of AGC, I warrant, represent, promise, and agree to the following:

1. I will obey the rules and regulations of the Club, especially those pertaining to the safe use of firearms. If I believe myself or anything in my vicinity to be unsafe, I will advise Club officials, and I will leave the shooting area or otherwise refuse to participate further in any activity.

2. I understand that outdoor activities and shooting sports can be dangerous, and I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily ASSUME ALL RISKS involved in those activities, including the risk of personal or bodily injury.

3. I RELEASE and PROMISE NOT TO SUE the Club, its officers, directors, agents, employees, attorneys, members, volunteers, sanctioning bodies, score keepers and officials, event participants and competitors, or third party event promoters (including sponsors or advertisers) for any damage or injury to me or my property arising in any way out of any activity of any nature whatsoever occurring on AGC property, and I WAIVE all related claims and causes of action.

4. I will INDEMNIFY and HOLD the Club HARMLESS from any loss, damage, claim, or cost of any nature either caused by or asserted by, through, or against me, whether caused by my negligence, the negligence of any other person, or as a result of an unavoidable accident. This indemnity includes court costs and attorney's fees.

5. I understand that in addition to me, this release is also binding upon my heirs, personal representatives, and assigns, and it also inures to the benefit of the Club, its successors, assigns, and the persons identified in paragraph 3 above. I intend this release to be as broad as possible under the laws of the State of Texas.

Shooter Conduct & Safety

Welcome to the Amarillo Gun Club. Observe the following at all times – no exceptions:

- Check in at the Clubhouse, provide identification, and make payment arrangements before shooting.
- No shot size large than 12 ga., 7 ½ target load on AGC property at any time. No three inch (3") or "magnum" shells. (i.e., 7½, 8, 8½, 9 target loads only) _____ [initial here]
- 'Riot' guns or shotguns with 22" or shorter barrels and extended or combat magazines WILL NOT BE PERMITTED on any field at AGC. (With the exception of youth type smaller gauge pump or auto loaders for kids).
- No pistols or rifles at any time – this is a shotgun only clay target facility.
- Guns must be open and unloaded at all times unless actively on a shooting post, pointed downrange. Guns must be open/unloaded when changing posts. "The only real safety is an unloaded, open gun."
- No extra shells in any gun at any time.
- Shooting is allowed only on active fields, during fully staffed operating hours.
- Eye and ear protection is mandatory.
- Keep noise and talking to a minimum near voice releases; turn off voice releases after shooting.
- No shooting after consumption of an alcoholic beverage – no alcoholic beverages on or near the shooting line.
- Stop and report unsafe activity immediately. "See it, stop it, report it."
- Observe common sense gun safety and good sportsmanship at all times.
- Pay for all rounds before leaving the facility. Unpaid rounds are stolen rounds. Members are responsible for the conduct of (and payment for) their guests.

Violation of Amarillo Gun Club safety rules or those of any sanctioning body will result in immediate ejection from our grounds.

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Club Rules

1. You must have safety glasses, approved sunglasses and hearing protection before shooting.

2. 7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2, and 9 shot; 2&3/4 in for 12 ga., 3" in .410, no more than 3 1/2 dram loads for shotshells

3. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on station and ready to call for a target

4. Your firearm must be cased and unloaded when you arrive to the gun club

5. Make sure you have the correct ga. Shells for your gun: 12 for 12, 20 for 20, 28 for 28, .410 for .410

6. LOAD ONE SHELL FOR SINGLES AND 2 FOR DOUBLES ONLY!

7. When you arrive at the gun club, come to the office, sign in and get an assigned field.

8. If you encounter a strange sounding load with less than normal power, unload and check for a stuck wad in the barrel. A barrel obstruction has deadly consequences on the field.

9. An orange cone on a traphouse indicates that the house is being loaded with targets. Unload, step back and wait for the employee to complete loading and exit the traphouse.

10. When entering ANY FIELD make sure your gun is OPEN and UNLOADED before stepping onto a station.

11. If a shell does not fire, hold your firearm pointed downrange for at least 20 seconds in case you have a slow burn or faulty primer. Unload, then reload with a fresh shell and fire again. If the gun does not fire, it could be a mechanical problem. Unload and bring firearm to office.

12 Make sure you chamber the correct round for your gun. 12 ga. (Red) 20 ga. (Yellow). 28 ga. and 410 have several different color combinations so make sure you have the correct shell for your gun.

13 Be respectful of your fellow shooters; refrain from loud talking or activity that may cause a shooter to lose concentration.

14 Nothing shorter than 22" barrel. A youth type gun is allowed if approved by the Board. Military and tactical shotguns are not allowed.

15 Drugs and alcohol are not allowed on the fields. Suspensions will result in you being escorted from the Club and permanently banned upon an investigation by the Board of Directors.

16 The safety on your gun is mechanical and can fail. The only safe gun is unloaded and open at Amartillo Gun Club.

17 If you encounter any firearm malfunction, immediately bring your firearm to the office and let me look at it for you. There are plenty of members with experience to help you with your firearm.

18 The electronic voice calls must be turned off when no one is shooting. They are prone to wasting targets when too much noise is picked up by the microphones.

19 Every shooter at Amartillo Gun Club is expected to follow every rule, and be courteous to other shooters and employees and pay for the targets shot. Unpaid rounds are stolen rounds.
